The Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation informs that in accordance with the Decree of the President of the Russian Federation dated 24 June 2019 No. 290 “On the Introduction of Changes into Certain Decrees of the President of the Russian Federation” (hereinafter – Decree No. 290) transit of sanctioned goods for international road and rail haulage to third countries through the territory of the Russian Federation is allowed as from 6 April 2020. Such movements are possible with the use of electronic navigation seals.

The list of border crossing points at the national border of the Russian Federation, of permanent and mobile checkpoints or checkpoints located at railway stations, as well as requirements for electronic navigation seals, procedure for transit transportation of certain types of agricultural products, raw materials and food, the country of origin of which is the state that took the decision to introduce economic sanctions against Russian legal entities and (or) individuals or state that aligned with this decision, and transportation of certain types of goods, the country of origin or country of dispatch of which is Ukraine or which is transported through the territory of Ukraine, and the procedure for issuing reporting vouchers were approved by the Regulation of the Government of the Russian Federation, dated 27 December 2019 No. 1877 “On Measures Implementing the Decree No. 290 “On the Introduction of Changes into Several Decrees of the President of the Russian Federation, dated 24 June 2019” (hereinafter – Regulation No. 1877).

Requirements to sealing operators and procedure for applying electronic seals are determined by Order No. 13 of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation

dated 14 January, 2020 “On Transit International Road Transport Haulage and Transit International Railway Transport Haulage through the territory of the Russian Federation to Third Countries while Ensuring Their Traceability with the Use of a Control System Envisaging Application of Identification Facilities (seals), Operating on the Basis of Technology of the GLONASS Global Navigation Satellite System”.

The operator for the provision of the sealing service in the territory of the Russian Federation is the limited liability company “Centre for the Development of Digital Platforms” (LLC “CRCP”). At present, service offices are operating at 30 crossing points at the national border of the Russian Federation and at permanent and mobile checkpoints or at checkpoints located at railway stations.
