Changes to GOV.UK guidance

We are writing to advise you that the GOV.UK guidance for [when to make an Exit Summary \(EXS\) declaration](#) has been updated based on user feedback. EXS declarations have been required for certain movements between GB and the EU since 1 October 2021.

We have also made some minor amendments to the [Safety and Security Requirements on imports and exports](#) document on GOV.UK. The changes are:
